

# What are the top 3 most pressing global risks ?



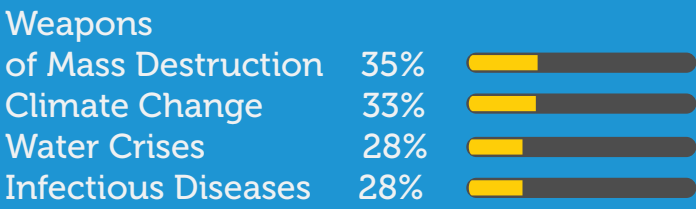

## The risks included:

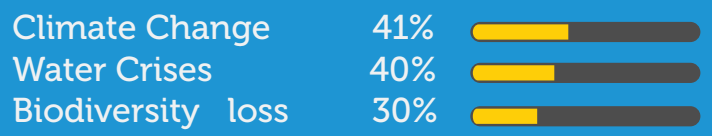
- 1 Failure of climate-change mitigation and adaptation

- 10 Profound social instability



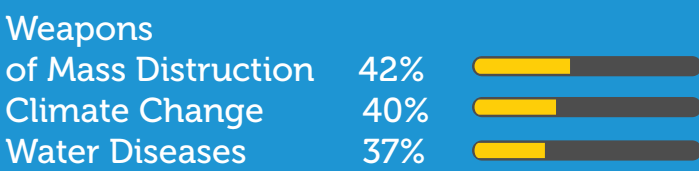
